## About Us

In terms of the Trust Deed dated 24th August 1970 the Trustees are empowered to apply the income and capital of the Trust Fund to Registered Charitable organisations in the United Kingdom. In so doing the Trustees give consideration to the known interest of the settlors and give considerable weight to applications for assistance from local community organisations and, to an extent, from similar organisations in Scotland.

## Geographic Factors

Whilst the Trustees are not restricted as to the location of charities to be assisted it is their preference and practice to support charities operating in Dundee and Tayside.

## General Guidelines

The Trustees have adopted the following guidelines in determining the suitability of applications:-

- a. Areas of support – Music, Children's Welfare, Education, Youth Activities.
- b. Local charities preferred.
- c. Geographical area preferred Dundee/Angus/Tayside/North Fife.
- d. Small charities preferred where small donations would make a big difference.
- e. No support where activities are not local.

## Trustee Meetings

The Trustees meet twice in every year, generally in March and October.

## Applications

Applications must be made in writing and should be addressed to the Trust's Agents, Thorntons Law LLP, Whitehall House, 33 Yeaman Shore, Dundee DD1 4BJ (Ref: SHY).

Applications should contain information about the organisation, including a copy of the most recent accounts.

Applicants should be registered charities in which case their registered charity number should be stated. No application from an individual will be considered unless the work to be undertaken by that individual is related to a registered charity: in such cases any donation would be made to that charity.

Applications by telephone are not accepted nor is it possible to advise applicants as to the merits of possible applications or the progress of applications by telephone.
